



## **NL Scholarship Terms and Conditions**

- 1. The NL Scholarship Incoming is not a full scholarship. It is a contribution towards the student's living expenses and study costs during the first year of the study programme.
- 2. The student may not have previously followed a bachelor's programme in the Netherlands and may not be enrolled at another Dutch research university or university of applied sciences.
- 3. The students must have completed their pre-university education outside the Netherlands.
- 4. The NL Scholarship Incoming can only be requested/awarded for the first academic year of a bachelor's programme in the Netherlands.
- 5. The NL Scholarship Incoming is awarded to talented students who are selected on the basis of their prior academic achievement, motivation and extra-curricular activities.
- 6. The student may not be an EU/EEA, Suriname or Swiss passport holder and may not be eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee tariff at Leiden University.
- 7. The student may not be eligible for support under the Dutch student finance system (Studiefinanciering in Dutch), and may not be eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee. - 8. The student must notify Leiden University immediately in case of any changes to their nationality, type of residence permit or eligibility for Dutch student finance during the course of the academic year.
- 9. The student must comply with Dutch visa and residence permit regulations and the admission/application procedures of Leiden University.
- 10. The NL Scholarship Incoming is granted for the academic year as specified in the decision letter and cannot be transferred to another academic year or a later intake within the same academic year. If the student changes the dates of their study programme, the scholarship will be revoked.
- 11. Students can only be awarded the NL Scholarship Incoming once.
- 12. The NL Scholarship Incoming will be paid in one instalment into a SEPA bank account upon completion of all Leiden University student registration formalities.





- 13. The student must accept the scholarship in the uSis scholarship portal by the deadline stated in the communication sent to them via uSis. If the awardee does not accept the scholarship before the deadline stated, the NL Scholarship Incoming will be withdrawn.
- 14. During their studies at Leiden University, the student will take an active role in promotional activities for the NL Scholarship Incoming.
- 15. By submitting an application for the NL Scholarship Incoming via Leiden University's uSis scholarship portal, the student agrees that certain personal and contact details will be shared with Nuffic for reporting and marketing purposes.
