

Kunstgeschiedenis/ Arts, Media and Society

- Kunstgeschiedenis in Leiden: traditionally strong in decorative arts, object-based but also theory, World Art Studies
- •Arts, Media and Society: English taught track within BA KG, established in 2017, with more focus on contemporary art and its interrelatedness with media and societal issues (but with attention for historical context)
- For instance: Bio-art, Activist art,
- •Students letter to the Board June 2020 signed by 60 students

Students' letter: main concerns

- Western/ European centered worldview
- Promise of 'discovering the (art-) world' not fulfilled
- Inclusivity of the art world
- •Traditional art history classes not self-reflective enough (for instance, museums and collections – colonial past)
- More diverse academic resources needed non-white authors/ lecturers
- More social themes needed (AMS)
- •Ratio attention European art arts from Africa, Asia, Oceania, South America - unequal

Students' letter: demands

- More lectures on colonial history artworld/ inclusion different perspectives – other epistemologies
- Guest lectures academics specialized in these fields
- More attention for these topics in lectures by current staff
- More diversity within the staff
- Provide students with the competences to be worldly/ critical citizens

Response board

- Two discussion meetings with students and staff
- Course Inclusive curriculum
- •Inventory on what we as lecturers can do in our courses
- •BA curriculum reform (2022)

Challenges - opportunities

- More lectures on colonial history artworld/ inclusion different perspectives
- •BA program is limited (in terms of EC/time) we want to be inclusive but not superficial
- Guest lectures academics specialized in these fields
- Budget
- More attention for these topics in lectures by current staff
- Awareness, willingness, expertise but many opportunities
- More diversity within the staff
- How to bypass the usual suspects?
- Provide students with the competences to be worldly/ critical citizens
- Perhaps the letter exemplifies they have acquired these competences themselves already
