The De la Court Prize recognises individuals who have produced outstanding scholarly work in the social sciences or humanities without financial reward, independently and outside the established academic institutions. The prizewinner receives a monetary award of EUR 7,500.

### **Lira Fonds Beurzenregeling Wetenschappelijke Boeken (open for all disciplines)**

### **Open Science Meetings (open for several disciplines)**

### **Gerda Henkel Stiftung PhD Scholarships**

In line with one of the founder's wishes, a special focus of the Gerda Henkel Foundation is support for up-and-coming scholars. Special attention is made when approving grants to enable qualified young researchers of both sexes to conduct scientific work for a limited period of time and in order to improve their academic training. Applications for PhD scholarships are considered throughout the year.

### **BIMTECH Research Fellowship for Young Global Scholars (open for all disciplines)**

The BIMTECH Research Fellowship scheme is to provide opportunities to researchers from foreign B Schools/Universities to undertake advanced studies in India leading to research outcomes.
