Open Mind 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Researchers with ideas for improving the world can apply for funding through Open Mind. NWO Domain Applied and Engineering Sciences (AES) is looking for surprising new research ideas in which technology is used to obtain applications with a societal impact. Researchers are invited to submit out-of-the-box ideas providing sustainable solutions for global societal challenges (in line with people, planet, profit).

Deadline: 12 March 2024

NWO Talent Programme Vici SSH 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Vici is part of the NWO Talent programme. The Vici target group consists of researchers at the stage of consolidation and further development of their leadership/research group.

Deadline pre-registration: 12 March 2024

Deadline full application: 10 September 2024

NWA Science Communication 2024 (open for all disciplines)

The call 'NWA Science Communication' funds projects that aim to strengthen the connection between science and society. For example by offering new science communication concepts to target groups without obvious links with science.

Closing date full application 14 March 2024

SSH Open Competition XS 2024 - round 1 (open for all disciplines)

The NWO Domain Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) has 3 different funding programmes in the Open Competition. These grants are for ideas that hold great promise (XS) and for large-scale grants (M, L).

The SSH-XS grants are available for projects with a maximum budget of 50,000 euro to enable proposals for curiosity-driven, fundamental research in the research fields covered by the NWO Domain SSH.

Deadline Round 1: 19 March 2024 (Round 2: 27 August, Round 3: 15 October 2024)

Demonstrator 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Researchers who want to apply knowledge from their research and bring it to the market can apply for funding from NWO to further develop this knowledge into a demonstrator. In a Demonstrator project, all preparatory activities are carried out that are necessary to transfer the underlying demonstrator knowledge to a third party.

Deadline: 19 March 2024

Research into Collections with a Colonial Context (CADS)

Researchers from organisations in countries of origin (including the autonomous countries in Kingdom of the Netherlands and the special municipalities) of objects and collections with a colonial context in Dutch museums may apply for a short-term research exchange grant or a larger consortium grant to create a sustainable research network.

Deadline: 19 March 2024

Rubicon 2024-1 (open for all disciplines)

Rubicon aims to encourage talented researchers who recently received their PhD to spend some time at research institutes outside of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to further their scientific career.

Deadline: 26 March 2024

Open Call Lowlands Science 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Collecting research data for three consecutive days at a festival with over 50,000 potential test subjects. A collaboration with festival organizers, artists and scientists makes that possible. It creates innovative forms of science that provide unique data for research. Data not easily obtainable within a research institute.

Deadline: 31 March 2024

NWO Hop-On Call for Researchers Based in Ukraine: NWO-NRFU Partnership Initiative (open for all disciplines)

NRFU and NWO have agreed on cooperation and joining forces. Scientists in Ukraine will have the opportunity to cooperate with scientists in the Kingdom of the Netherlands and thus continue their scientific careers under difficult conditions.

Deadline: 8 April 2024

Dutch Research Agenda - Research along Routes by Consortia 2024 (NWA-ORC 2024) (open for all disciplines)

In the annual ORC funding round, consortia can submit thematic proposals that provide a joint expression of the breadth and innovative character of the NWA. Deadline for submitting an initiative: 9 April 2024

Deadline for submission of proposals: 1 October 2024

Tackling Global Challenges through Use-inspired Research. SDG Scaling Grants (open for several disciplines)

This call offers researchers within the Joint SDG research initiative the opportunity to enhance the uptake potential of tangible solutions in research results on different scales. Aims of this programme are to promote scaling of promising innovations for the achievement of the SDG Agenda and to support the conceptual knowledge base, learning and research capacity of early career professionals.

Deadline: 16 April 2024

NGF AiNed XS Europe 24-1 (open for all disciplines)

The NGF AiNed XS Europe grants are intended to support promising ideas and to facilitate innovative and more speculative initiatives that focus on the challenges outlined in the national AI research agenda AIREA-NL and are designed in collaboration with at least one European collaborative partner organization. The proposed research is ground-breaking and involves a real risk of failure.

Deadlines: 18 April and 8 October 2024

NGF: Making Carbon Neutral Hydrogen (CADS)

This call is part of the R&D programme GroenvermogenNL, financed by the National Growth Fund. This current Call concerns NGF: Making carbon neutral hydrogen, GroenvermogenNL WP1, and focuses on fundamental innovations for cost efficient and large-scale production of carbon neutral hydrogen.

Deadline: 25 April 2024

KIC MISSION Top-up Human Capital Working on social impact for the energy transition & sustainability (open for several disciplines)

The KIA Energy Transition & Sustainability (ET&S) attaches great importance to human capital in its quest for social impact. The aim of this call for proposals is to increase the societal impact of ongoing research projects by addressing and strengthening the human capital factor in the projects.

Deadline: 21 May 2024

Large-scale Research Infrastructure (LSRI) – National Roadmap Consortia 2024 (open for all disciplines)

This call concerns the second funding round for the National Roadmap for Large-Scale Research Infrastructure 2021 (Roadmap LSRI 2021). Only Roadmap consortia associated to one or more of the Groups as defined in the Roadmap 2021 can apply for funding for realization of their LSRI-plans.

Deadline for statements of intent: 29 May 2024

Deadline for applications: 24 September 2024

Top-up Impact Explorer (open for all disciplines)

A small top-up, for ongoing research-projects in the open competition or talent line, to explore an unforeseen opportunity for impact.

The purpose of this Call for Proposals is to explore opportunities for societal impact arising from curiosity-driven research. These are opportunities and ideas that were not anticipated in advance when the project plan was made, but have emerged during the lifetime of a project. Make sure to contact the [Luris Knowledge brokers \(KTO\)](#) – mandatory and helpful.

Deadline: continuous

Open Access Books (open for all disciplines)

Project leaders or co-applicants of awarded NWO research projects can apply for funding of the costs of Open Access publishing of academic books that result from NWO funding.

Cooperation Germany - Von Humboldt Stiftung (VHS) (open for all disciplines)

The NWO invites eminent researchers to nominate German candidates for a Von Humboldt Prize and German researchers to nominate Dutch candidates. The aim is to encourage international collaboration between excellent researchers.

Kennisontwikkeling Passende Zorg binnen de Wet Langdurige Zorg (Psychology)

NIAS Individual Fellowship (open for all disciplines)

NIAS offers individual fellowships to scholars who wish to carry out independent research in the humanities and the social sciences. For five or ten months, scholars are offered time and space to work on their own research project as part of an interdisciplinary community.

ODISSEI Social Data Science fellowship (SoDa fellowship) (open for all disciplines)

Successful SoDa fellows will spend between 3-8 months full-time working on a social science research project they propose.

This grant program funds individual research projects undertaken by doctorates in anthropology or a closely related field. Our goal is to support vibrant and significant work that furthers our understanding of what it means to be human.

Every year, the Niels Stensen Fellowship Committee awards seven grants to enable young, recent postdoctoral students to gain international experience abroad early in their careers.

(SIA) KIEM HighTech (open for all disciplines)

The aim of KIEM HighTech is to conduct (explorative) applied research through new practice-oriented research activities, in the field of KIA key technologies and associated roadmaps. A network of knowledge institutions and partners in the field carries out these research activities.

Gerda Henkel Stiftung (CADS, Psychology)

The funding activities concentrate basically on German and foreign academics in the fields of historical humanities. Candidates can apply regardless of their nationality and place of work.

The Holberg Prize is an international prize awarded for outstanding contributions to research in the arts and humanities, social sciences, law and theology. No self-nominations.

Fritz Thyssen Stiftung (open for several disciplines)

HFG Emerging Scholars (Political Science, CADS)

The Harry Frank Guggenheim Emerging Scholar Awards (formerly the Harry Frank Guggenheim Dissertation Fellowships) recognize promising researchers in their final year of writing a doctoral dissertation examining a salient aspect of violence.

Open Science Meetings (open for several disciplines)
