The KNAW Early Career Award recognizes innovative and original research and stimulates the further development of the careers of all kinds of early career researchers in various areas of scientific practice.

This grant program funds individual research projects undertaken by doctorates in anthropology or a closely related field. Our goal is to support vibrant and significant work that furthers our understanding of what it means to be human.

Niels Stensen Fellowship (open for all disciplines)

Every year, the Niels Stensen Fellowship Committee awards seven grants to enable young, recent postdoctoral students to gain international experience abroad early in their careers.

(SIA) KIEM HighTech (open for all disciplines)

The aim of KIEM HighTech is to conduct (explorative) applied research through new practice-oriented research activities, in the field of KIA key technologies and associated roadmaps. A network of knowledge institutions and partners in the field carries out these research activities.

Gerda Henkel Stiftung (CADS, Psychology)

The funding activities concentrate basically on German and foreign academics in the fields of historical humanities. Candidates can apply regardless of their nationality and place of work.

FNO: Klein Geluk call 1 voor eigen regie en participatie (Psychology)

Every year 12 research grants (one per research project) will be awarded to young women and men under 35 years of age, inviting them to address specific issues relating to the Silk Roads shared heritage and plural identities, as well as its internal diversity, and its potential in contemporary societies for creativity, intercultural dialogue, social cohesion, regional and international cooperation, and ultimately sustainable peace and development.

Deadline: 13 June 2024

Holberg Prize (open for all disciplines)

The Holberg Prize is an international prize awarded for outstanding contributions to research in the arts and humanities, social sciences, law and theology. No self-nominations.

Nomination deadline: 15 June 2024 for the 2025 Holberg Prize

Lira Fonds Beurzenregeling Wetenschappelijke Boeken (open for all disciplines)

Voor het vierde jaar op rij stelt Lira Fonds vier beurzen van €37.500 beschikbaar aan (bijna) gepromoveerde wetenschappers voor het schrijven van een Nederlandstalig populairwetenschappelijk boek. Een aanvraag moet vergezeld gaan van een aanbevelingsbrief van de eigen universiteit (of wetenschappelijk instituut) en een intentieverklaring van een uitgever.

Deadline: 30 juni 2024

ODISSEI Social Data Science fellowship (SoDa fellowship) (open for all disciplines)

The ODISSEI Social Data Science (SoDa) team offers SoDa fellowships for early career social scientists (i.e., PhD candidates, early career postdocs, pre-PhD researchers who have finished their studies).

Successful SoDa fellows will spend between 3-8 months full-time working on a social science research project they propose.

The deadlines for submission: 30 June 2024

Fritz Thyssen Stiftung (open for several disciplines)

Support of projects by the Fritz Thyssen Foundation focuses on scholars in the humanities, social sciences and biomedicine fields. The planned project should be limited in terms of the subject and time.

An application can be filed in the following areas of support: History, Language & Culture - State, Economy and Society.

Ammodo Science Fellowship 2024 (open for all disciplines)

This new fellowship offers early career researchers the opportunity to conduct high-quality research of their choice and expand their international network.

The fellowship will be granted biennially across four domains: Biomedical Sciences, Humanities, Natural Sciences and Social Sciences.

Deadline: 6 September 2024

HFG Emerging Scholars (Political Science, CADS)

The Harry Frank Guggenheim Emerging Scholar Awards (formerly the Harry Frank Guggenheim Dissertation Fellowships) recognize promising researchers in their final year of writing a doctoral dissertation examining a salient aspect of violence.

Deadline: 1 November 2024

Open Science Meetings (open for several disciplines)

Both researchers and research support staff may submit an application for financial support for organising an open science meeting. The aim of this instrument is to allow open science communities to organise meetings on topics of common interest.

Deadline: continuous, until 12 December 2024

BIMTECH Research Fellowship for Young Global Scholars (open for all disciplines)
