Modulation of brain ageing through nutrition and healthy lifestyle (NutriBrain) (open for several disciplines)

Within the European partnership ERA4Health, Dutch researchers can apply for funding for international research projects aimed at improving cognitive brain aging using diet and lifestyle factors. The goal of the projects should be to provide insight into the impact of lifestyle on brain aging and/or to test interventions to reduce the manifestation of cognitive impairment associated with pathological brain aging.

KIC Long-Term Programmes Strategy-driven consortia with impact (open for all disciplines)

Public-private consortia can apply for funding for a long-term programme (LTP) with a duration of 10 years. An LTP aims to develop and structurally stimulate a scientific field, on topics from the mission driven top sectors and innovation policy.

Deadline: 18 January 2024

NGF AiNed XS Europe 24-1 (open for all disciplines)

The NGF AiNed XS Europe grants are intended to support promising ideas and to facilitate innovative and more speculative initiatives that focus on the challenges outlined in the national AI research agenda AIREA-NL and are designed in collaboration with at least one European collaborative partner organization. The proposed research is ground-breaking and involves a real risk of failure.

Deadlines: 18 January, 18 April and 8 October 2024

Innofest X SIA 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Are you a researcher and do you - with a team - want to test a result from your research? Then with Innofest X [SIA](#) you can apply for funding for, for example, the preparation of such a test, the further development of prototypes and the performance of experiments at a festival or in a living lab. You can apply for a maximum of € 10,000.

NWA Science Communication 2024 (open for all disciplines)

The call 'NWA Science Communication' funds projects that aim to strengthen the connection between science and society. For example by offering new science communication concepts to target groups without obvious links with science.

Closing date full application 14 March 2024

Demonstrator 2024 (open for all disciplines)

Researchers who want to apply knowledge from their research and bring it to the market can apply for funding from NWO to further develop this knowledge into a demonstrator. In a Demonstrator project, all preparatory activities are carried out that are necessary to transfer the underlying demonstrator knowledge to a third party.

Deadline: 19 March 2024

Research into Collections with a Colonial Context (CADS)

Researchers from organisations in countries of origin (including the autonomous countries in Kingdom of the Netherlands and the special municipalities) of objects and collections with a colonial context in Dutch museums may apply for a short-term research exchange grant or a larger consortium grant to create a sustainable research network.

[NWO Hop-On Call for Researchers Based in Ukraine: NWO-NRFU Partnership Initiative](#) (open for all disciplines) NRFU and NWO have agreed on cooperation and joining forces. Scientists in Ukraine will have the opportunity to cooperate with scientists in the Kingdom of the Netherlands and thus continue their scientific careers under difficult conditions.

ODISSEI Social Data Science fellowship (SoDa fellowship) (open for all disciplines)
