EC: Council Implementing Decision 2022/2506 Hungarian Entities

The Council Implementing Decision 2022/2506 might directly impact the implementation of your EU grant. This Decision stipulates that legal commitments must not be entered into with any public interest trusts established on the basis of the Hungarian Act IX of 2021 or any entity maintained by such a public interest trust. This applies as of 16 December 2022 for as long as the measures are in place. This means that it is prohibited to enter into legal commitments with such entities involving Union funding. This prohibition applies to the entire chain of Union financing.

Use of NCO-database in PhD and Postdoc research 2023

This longitudinal education research is based on the registers of Statistics Netherlands (CBS) and DUO (Netherlands Education Executive Agency) and student monitoring systems, supplemented by modules that focus on specific subjects for which no register data are available.

PhD students and postdoc researchers who received their doctorate degree between June 1st 2018 and December 1st 2023, can apply for 5.000 euros that cover the material expenses that are made to obtain access to the database and performing analyses with NCO data in the remote access environment of the CBS.

Applications are submitted and continuously until 1st of December 2023 or when the budget is completely utilized.
