NWO to update its data management protocol in January 2020

Starting from 1st January 2020, NWO will update its data management protocol, reinforcing its longstanding commitment to Open Science. The basic principles will remain. NWO emphasizes the importance of responsible data management and expects researchers to carefully manage data resulting from NWO-funded research and prospectively plan for data sharing and preservation.

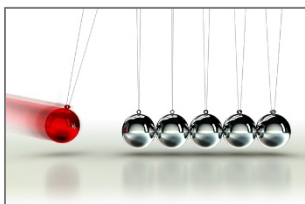
Urgent onderzoek

Het NRO heeft in toenemende mate te maken met het uitzetten van onderzoek naar urgente vragen met een korte looptijd en een relatief klein bedrag waarbij het van belang is dat er snel gestart kan worden. De gebruikelijke procedure is hiervoor ongeschikt, onder andere vanwege de grote investering aan de kant van aanvragers en de langere doorlooptijd. Het NRO heeft daarom een nieuwe procedure ontwikkeld voor het snel starten van relatief kort onderzoek naar urgente vragen.



Vanaf 19 november 2019 kan het NRO de registraties in de database gebruiken voor het uitzetten van kleine subsidies. We raden onderzoekers daarom aan om zich zo spoedig mogelijk in de database te registreren.

Call: Transnational actions on asylum, migration and integration

The European Union's objective to constitute an area of freedom, security and justice should be achieved, inter alia, through common measures framing a policy on asylum and immigration, based on solidarity between Member States, which is fair towards third countries and their nationals.

❖ **Fostering the integration of persons in need of protection through private sponsorship schemes**

As part of the EU efforts to provide more legal channels for the growing number of displaced persons in need of international protection, the European Commission invited Member States to explore ways to establish private sponsorship schemes where civil society organisations provide support for the settlement and integration for persons in need of protection.

❖ **Social orientation of newly arrived third-country nationals through involvement of local communities, including mentoring and volunteering activities**

Upon arrival and in the very early stages of the integration process, migrants often encounter difficulties in their social orientation, i.e. in adapting to a new local, social and administrative environment, building a social network, as well as in dealing with authorities, public and private services or handling paperwork. These difficulties can slow down the integration process and affect its outcome.

❖ **Social and economic integration of migrant women**

Women can be crucial facilitators in the integration process. When they have children, they are often multipliers in the areas of education and employment and play an important role as agents for the transfer of values. The positive impact of migrant women' employment on the social outcomes of their children is well documented.

❖ **Support to victims of trafficking in human beings**

Providing better access to and realising the rights of the victims of trafficking in human beings is a priority under the 2017 Communication 'Reporting on the follow-up to the EU Strategy towards the eradication of trafficking in human beings and identifying further concrete actions.

❖ **Awareness raising and information campaigns on the risks of irregular migration in selected third countries and within Europe**

The EU Action plan against migrant smuggling states that raising awareness of the risks of smuggling and irregular migration is crucial for preventing prospective migrants and asylum seekers, including people in more vulnerable situations such as children, from embarking on hazardous journeys towards the EU.

❖ **Protection of children in migration**

Migrant children continue to arrive to the EU in relatively large numbers. From the 34,376 irregular migrants who arrived to the EU by land or sea or land in the first half of 2019, 23% are children.

In the area of asylum and migration, the national administrations of EU Member States are confronted with a wide range of different tasks and activities requiring high level of expertise.
