Pre-announcement: new call Research Infrastructure: national consortia

With the research programme 'Research Infrastructure: national consortia', NWO finances research infrastructure that enables innovative science. With this funding, NWO is strengthening the scientific infrastructure that Dutch knowledge institutions

can make available to the whole research community. Scientists from throughout the Netherlands often work together and with international partners within the projects who

the Netherlands often work together and with international partners within the projects where the new facilities will be realised.

The call for proposals for the new round in the research programme 'Research Infrastructure (RI): national consortia' is expected to open in October.

Dutch Research Agenda - Research along Routes by Consortia 2023 (NWA-ORC 2023) (multidisciplinary)

In the annual ORC funding round, consortia can submit thematic proposals that provide a joint expression of the breadth and innovative character of the NWA. The funding round is aimed at facilitating research that leads to scientific and/or societal breakthroughs.

Deadline: 3 October 2023 (pre-registration)/21 March 2024 (full proposal)

Perspectief round 2023/2024 (multidisciplinary)

NWO Domain AES invites researchers and users (companies, societal organisations) to jointly submit new, challenging research projects within the application-oriented and technical sciences that generate economic and social impact in thematic areas relevant to the Netherlands.

Submission of statement of intent: 10 October 2023, pre-proposal: 14 Nov. 2023 proposal: 14 May 2024

Research into causes and forms of Loneliness (CAOS, Education & Child Studies, Psychology)

We know little about the different forms of loneliness experienced by different groups in society or the causes of loneliness and effective approaches for tackling it. Moreover, the translation of available knowledge into practice, the promotion of expertise among professionals and volunteers, and the development of policy in the field of loneliness are lagging behind. The NWA Loneliness programme aims to change all of this.

Deadline: 10 October 2024 Phase II

NWA Drought in the build environment (CADS, Political Science, Psychology)

Increasing periods of drought have various harmful consequences in the built environment. The NWA program Drought in the built environment (DroBE) contributes to insight into this drought problem and aims to provide governments with tools to tackle the drought problem.

Deadline: 17 October 2023 (phase 1 sub-proposals) Deadline: 28 May 2024 (phase 2 full proposals)

Faculty of Impact Life Sciences and Health (CADS, Psychology)

The Faculty of Impact program is aimed at researchers who want to achieve impact with their research and are interested in setting up their own company. These researchers can now submit a grant application to become a so-called "fellow" at the Faculty of Impact. A maximum of € 185,000 is available per application. The duration of this program is two years.

Deadline for submitting a fully detailed application is Tuesday 31 October 2023

NWO-Talentprogramme | Vidi - Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) 2023 (multidisciplinary)

Vidi is part of the NWO Talent Programme. Vidi is for researchers who have carried out several years of postdoctoral research after their PhD and allows them to develop their own innovative research line and appoint one or more researchers to this end.

Deadline for submitting preproposals is 2 November 2023

Deadline for submitting full proposals is 26 March 2024

Storm Surge Barriers in a Liveable Delta (Political Science, CADS) Info meeting 13 October

This NWA programme intends to provide methods and/or instruments to enable well-considered choices for the maintenance, renovation, strengthening and/or replacement of storm surge barriers

Biodiversa+ call - Nature-Based Solutions for biodiversity, human well-being and transformative change (BiodivNBS) (CADS, Political Science, Psychology)

Full, associate and assistant professors, lectors and other researchers with a comparable appointment can submit an application to conduct research on Nature-Based Solutions for biodiversity, human well-being and transformative change.

Deadline for submitting a pre-proposal (compulsory) is 10 November 10 2023

Deadline for submitting a full proposal is 9 April 9 2024

Rubicon 2023-3 (multidisciplinary)

Rubicon aims to encourage talented researchers who recently received their PhD to spend some time at research institutes outside of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to further their scientific career.

Deadline: 28 November 2023

KIC Long-Term Programmes Strategy-driven consortia with impact (multidisciplinary)

Public-private consortia can apply for funding for a

long-term programme (LTP) with a duration of 10 years. An LTP aims to develop and structurally stimulate a scientific field, on topics from the mission driven top sectors and innovation policy. Deadline: 18 January 2024

NWO Hop-On Call for Researchers Based in Ukraine: NWO-NRFU Partnership Initiative (multidisciplinary)

NRFU and NWO have agreed on cooperation and joining forces. Scientists in Ukraine will have the opportunity to cooperate with scientists in the Kingdom of the Netherlands and thus continue their scientific careers under difficult conditions.

Deadline: 8 April 2023

Top-up Impact Explorer (multidisciplinary)

A small top-up, for ongoing research-projects in the open competition or talent line, to explore an unforeseen opportunity for impact.

The purpose of this Call for Proposals is to explore opportunities for societal impact arising from curiosity-driven research. These are opportunities and ideas that were not anticipated in advance when the project plan was made, but have emerged during the lifetime of a project. Make sure to contact the Luris Knowledge brokers (KTO) – mandatory and helpful.

Deadline: continuous

Open Access Books (multidisciplinary)

Project leaders or co-applicants of awarded NWO research projects can apply for funding of the costs of Open Access publishing of academic books that result from NWO funding.

Deadline: continuous

Cooperation Germany - Von Humboldt Stiftung (VHS) (multidisciplinary)

The NWO invites eminent researchers to nominate German candidates for a Von Humboldt Prize and German researchers to nominate Dutch candidates. The aim is to encourage international collaboration between excellent researchers.

Use of NCO-database in PhD and Postdoc research 2023

This longitudinal education research is based on the registers of Statistics Netherlands (CBS) and DUO (Netherlands Education Executive Agency) and student monitoring systems, supplemented by modules that focus on specific subjects for which no register data are available.

PhD students and postdoc researchers who received their doctorate degree between June 1st 2018 and December 1st 2023, can apply. Applications are submitted and continuously until 1st of December 2023 or when the budget is completely utilized.

Kennisbenutting Plus (education and child studies)

Kennisbenutting Plus is a grant for activities that stimulate the utilization of educational research. A budget of \leqslant 60.000 is available. Since this grant is focused on Dutch education, all documentation is in Dutch.

The Academy regards awards as an important means of showcasing outstanding and promising researchers. They also serve to spotlight specific areas of research and/or the arts. In addition, the Academy runs a number of incentive programmes specifically meant to encourage research excellence, in particular among young scientists

and scholars. The Academy offers several awards and funding possibilities.

NIAS - one of the institutes of the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW) – has made it its mission to provide a physical and intellectual space for advanced research in the humanities and social sciences that is driven by curiosity and cross-discipline collaboration.

KNAW Van der Gaag Grant

The KNAW Van der Gaag Grant helps young behavioural researchers cover the cost of a research project or working visit abroad. A KNAW Van der Gaag Grant consists of a cash sum not exceeding EUR 9,700. Deadline: 1 November 2023

Statesman Thorbecke Fund Programme

The Statesman Thorbecke Fund Programme is for research projects that have a strong connection with the Dutch statesman Johan Rudolf Thorbecke. Preference is given to projects carried out by a postdoctoral researcher. A project may be awarded up to EUR 200,000 in funding.

Deadline: 1 December 2023

Call opens on 1 October 2023: Faces of Science

ODISSEI

ODISSEI (Open Data Infrastructure for Social Science and Economic Innovations) is the national research infrastructure for the social sciences in the Netherlands. ODISSEI brings together researchers with the

necessary data, expertise and resources to conduct ground-breaking research and embrace the computational turn in social enquiry. <u>News</u>

ODISSEI Social Data Science fellowship (SoDa fellowship) (multidisciplinary)

The ODISSEI Social Data Science (SoDa) team offers SoDa fellowships for early career social scientists (i.e., PhD candidates, early career postdocs, pre-PhD researchers who have finished their studies). Successful SoDa fellows will spend between 3-8 months full-time working on a social science research project they propose.

The deadlines for submission are the following:

30 September 2023, 31 December 2023, 31 March 2024, 30 June 2024

UKRI: Behavioural Science for Security and Defence Network Plus (multidisciplinary)

Apply for funding to develop a Network Plus to enable new understanding of how individual and population level risks evolve and how security threats can be identified and mitigated.

Deadline: 12 October 2023

Stichting tot Steun VCVGZ (Psychology)

The "Stichting tot Steun VCVGZ" invites researchers to apply for funding. Deadlines: 16 October 2023, 18 March 2024, 30 September 2024

<u>Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies - Jean Monnet Fellowships</u>

The Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies (RSC) offers one-year Jean Monnet Fellowships to scholars who have obtained their doctorate more than 5 years prior to the start of the fellowship, i.e. 1 September 2024 for the academic year 2024-25.

Deadline: 25 October 2023

Niehaus Visiting Fellowship Program in Regional Political Economy (Political Science)

The Niehaus Center for Globalization and Governance (NCGG) at Princeton University's School of Public and International Affairs, hosts a Visiting Research Scholar Program in regional political economy for faculty members applying to spend their leave year with NCGG. This fellows' program is targeted at developing a generation of scholars able to analyze and make policy recommendations about the regional political economy in the Middle East, East, South, or Southeast Asia, Africa and Latin America. Deadline: 1 November 2023

The British Academy-Knowledge Frontiers: International Interdisciplinary Research Projects 2024 (multidisciplinary)

This programme provides UK-based early career researchers, active in any discipline within the humanities or the social sciences, with the opportunity to develop and lead international and interdisciplinary research projects.

Deadline: 1 November 2023

BIMTECH Research Fellowship for Young Global Scholars

The BIMTECH Research Fellowship scheme is to provide opportunities to researchers from foreign B Schools/Universities to undertake advanced studies in India leading to research outcomes. Deadline: ongoing (selection meets only three time a year - March, July and November)

LNVH Distinguished Women Scientists Fund (DWSF) 2023-2024

In 2012 the Dutch Network of Women Professors created the Distinguished Women Scientists Fund, a travel grant (max. 1500 euro) for female postdocs - up to 3 years after promotion and working in the Netherlands - who wish to travel abroad in the framework of their discipline.

Deadline: 15 December 2023

The Branco Weiss Fellowship

The ideal applicant for a Branco Weiss Fellowship leverages the freedom offered by the fellowship to design a surprisingly novel and scientifically rigorous research project.

Deadline: 15 January 2024

Kroc Institute Visiting Research Fellowship 2024-2025

Each year, the Kroc Institute's Visiting Research Fellows Program brings outstanding scholars focused on peace research to the University of Notre Dame for a semester or full academic year.

Deadline: 31 January 2024

Wissenschaftskolleg zu Berlin Fellowships (multidisciplinary)

In each "class", the Wissenschaftskolleg strives to put together a group of Fellows that is greater than the sum of its individual members. To this end, the Wissenschaftskolleg invites outstanding researchers from all disciplines and from all over the world for a research year in Berlin.

Deadline: continuous

Wenner-Gren Conference and Workshop Grant (CADS)

This grant program supports meetings and events that promote the development of inclusive communities of anthropologists and advance significant and innovative research. Conferences that we support are public events directed at large audiences of anthropologists.

Deadlines: application deadlines are June 1 and December 1. The June 1 deadline is for conferences and workshops to be held no earlier than January 1 of the following year. The December 1 deadline is for conferences and workshops to be held no earlier than July 1 of the following year

The Georg Forster Research Fellowship

The Georg Forster Research Fellowship supports postdoctoral and experienced researchers from developing and transition countries to conduct their research in Germany. Fellows will benefit from individual support from the Humboldt Foundation and their diverse sponsorship portfolio. Continuous deadline.

National Institute for Health Research (Psychology)

UK's largest funder of health and care research, working in partnership with the NHS, universities, local government, other research funders, patients and the public. Check their website for various funding possibilities.

IASH (University of Edinburgh) (multidisciplinary)

Several Fellowship programmes for external researchers. Various deadlines.

UKRI / ESRC New Investigator Grants (multidisciplinary)

New Investigator Grants will support new researchers and academics at the start of their careers to become independent researchers through gaining experience of managing and leading research projects and teams. In addition, they will provide applicants with anopportunity not only to support their own skill development but also the skill development of research staff employed on the grant.

There are no fixed closing dates – proposals can be submitted at any time

Hersenstichting (psychologie)

<u>Max-Planck-Gesellschaft</u> (multidisciplinary)

The Max Planck Society is one of Europe's leading basic research organizations. In its research laboratories, workshops, libraries, and administration, scientists and researchers perform demanding tasks with a high degree of autonomy and creativity.

DFG Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft: Emmy Noether Programme (multidisciplinary)

Outstanding junior researchers can rapidly qualify for leading positions in science and research or for a university teaching career by heading an independent junior research group and assuming relevant teaching duties.

Deadline: continuous

Volkswagen Stiftung (multidisciplinary)

Freigeist Fellowships support outstanding (junior) researchers who would like to conduct exceptional, high-risk research between established fields of research. They will assume the leadership of their own junior research group and receive the very broadest academic freedom for a clear time frame.

Deadline: continuous

The British Academy: Global Professorships (multidisciplinary)

This programme aims to demonstrate and further enhance the UK's commitment to international research partnerships and collaboration as well as strengthen the UK's research capacity and capability in the humanities and the social sciences.
