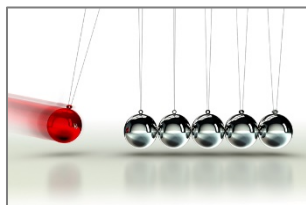

### Impact

#### Knowledge utilisation to create impact - NWO

Besides scientific impact, research should also have a societal impact and contribute to solving societal issues. Within the social sciences and humanities domain, much knowledge and experience has been gained in facilitating the societal impact of research, for example within the many thematic programmes and international collaborations. Research manuals have been developed to help social sciences and humanities researchers set up collaborative programmes and projects.

NWO's new policy on impact gradually is becoming visible in the different calls. For the Talent and Open Competition programmes the outlook impact approach will be used, which resembles the knowledge utilisation section. For thematic calls an impact plan approach will be used, which uses the 'theory of change'. This requires reasoning backwards from the future outcomes towards the research results (outputs) to be generated with the involvement of the stakeholders. To help you prepare the relevant section in the proposal, NWO has announced [e-learnings](#) for the KIC and NWA calls, respectively.

#### NWO funding instruments KIC 2020-2023

The NWO instruments for the Knowledge and Innovation Covenant (KIC) 2020-2023 provide funding for fundamental and practical research in a public-private partnership (PPP). The set of instruments consists of four main lines, for which 118 million euros has been reserved annually.

To give researchers sufficient time to prepare, NWO is already announcing how it will implement the guidelines for Plan S in its grant rules.

#### Talent Programme

The Talent Programme offers personal grants to talented, creative researchers. This enables them to conduct the research of their choice. The Talent Scheme has three funding instruments (Veni, Vidi, Vici) tailored to various phases in researchers' scientific careers. Researchers can apply for a maximum amount of 250,000 euros for Veni, 800,000 euros for Vidi, and 1.5 million euros for Vici.
