


### Resilient Society Platform


### Knowledge utilisation to create impact - NWO

### **Urgent onderzoek**

Het NRO heeft in toenemende mate te maken met het uitzetten van onderzoek naar urgente vragen met een korte looptijd en een relatief klein bedrag waarbij het van belang is dat er snel gestart kan worden. De gebruikelijke procedure is hiervoor ongeschikt, onder andere vanwege de grote investering aan de kant van aanvragers en de langere doorlooptijd.
