

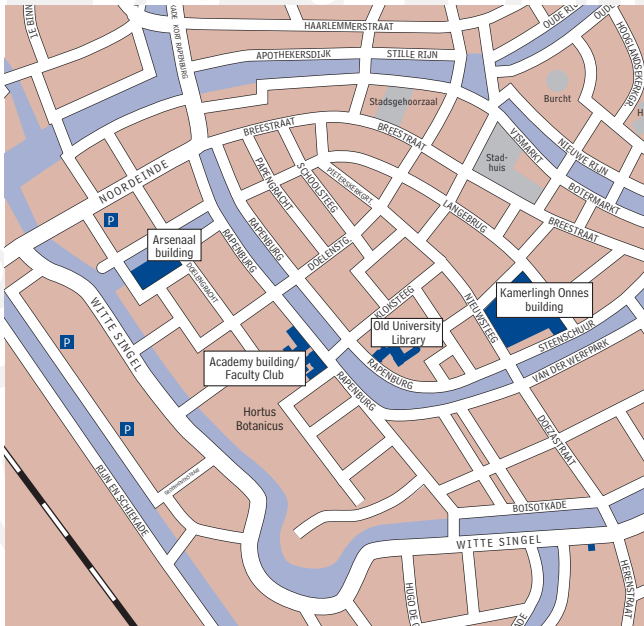
Catering

Accessibility and parking

The Faculty Club is located within the Academy Building. Paid parking is available in Leiden city centre. You can also park in the car park on the Maliebaan (behind the University library), or the car park on Haagweg, which is about 8 minutes walk from the Academy Building. In addition, a free shuttle bus operates between this car park and Rapenburg. Leiden station is about 10 minutes away on foot. Buses and (train) taxis depart from this station towards Rapenburg.

Universiteit Leiden



Academy Building

The former chapel of the convent of White Nuns has served as the main building of the university since 1581. The building has been fully renovated and is used to host various ceremonies. With an outstanding reception area and the Faculty Club, the Academy Building is an ideal location for all your corporate and celebratory events.



Old University Library

The Old University Library along the Rapenburg currently serves as an administrative building, however the imposing hall with marble embellishments and black-and-white tiles, the restaurant and the courtyard garden are available for receptions, parties, or dinners. The courtyard garden can even be partly covered over.



Kamerlingh Onnes Building

For a long time, the Kamerlingh Onnes Building was known as 'the coldest place on earth', because of physicist Kamerlingh Onnes' study of extremely low temperatures. Now the restored building has two imposing lecture-halls, a restaurant, the Juridisch Café and an abundance of options for receptions. It is perfectly suited to symposia, (department) events and other celebratory events.

Faculty Club

The Faculty Club in the Academy Building opens its doors ten years after its establishment. With a restaurant, brasserie, dining room and various meeting spaces that have access to the courtyard garden, the Faculty Club is a superb location.

Arsenaal Building

The Arsenaal is the only building reminiscent of the military history of the Witte Singel/Doelenterrein. The courtyard was roofed over after the building was taken into use by the university, making it ideal for fantastic parties, receptions or dinners.
